## Next Generation Assistant

### Purpose:

The assistant spends their 10 hours each week as a complement to the director of student ministries in planning, executing, and assessing activities related to student ministry. Individually, the assistant leads the charge for female ministry by building and maintaining relationships with students via large and small group activities both on and off site. Additionally, the assistant regularly plans “contact work” times with those students to expand their network of student relationships. As a member of the student ministry team, the assistant helps train and direct volunteers, works to plan larger events, and engages the Bethel community as an active member of our faith family.

### Areas of Ministry:

<b>40%</b>	Programmed Activity Leadership (youth group, small groups, etc)
<b>30%</b>	Non-programmed Time with Students (sporting events, one-on-one, etc)
<b>20%</b>	Leadership/Volunteer Development (volunteer training, personal reporting)
<b>10%</b>	Prep and Personal (lesson planning, additional events, spiritual development)

The assistant will be an energetic female with a mature relationship with Jesus and a desire to see students grow in their faith. While focusing on student ministries, they will be an active member of the Bethel community, furthering its vision to joyfully love, live, serve, and share Jesus Christ.
